

GARBAGE AND RECYCLING

Pickup is 7 a.m. on Wednesdays. Garbage and Recycling billing is included in the City of Bondurant monthly utility bill with Water and Sanitary Sewer fees.

Garbage is collected by Ankeny Sanitation for solid waste pickup.

COMPOST IT! SEASON

Yard waste bags and bundles are collected from the curb weekly during Compost It! Season. There are three options to use the bags and stickers. Stickers can be purchased at City Hall or online.



Purchase Compost It! Bags

Cost: \$8 plus tax for a bundle of five bags. No sticker required. The cost of the Compost It! Bag covers the cost of collection.

Tip: Do not exceed 40 pounds of weight per bag.

Compost It! Sticker + Store-brand Bag

Cost: \$1.25 plus tax per sticker plus cost of generic bag. The cost of the Compost It! Sticker covers the cost of collection. Attach one green Compost It! Sticker to each bag.

Tip: Do not exceed 40 pounds of weight per bag.



Compost It! Sticker + Brush Bundle

Cost: \$1.25 plus tax per sticker. Attach a Compost It! Sticker to each brush bundle and place it next to carts or bags. Bundles cannot exceed 18 inches in diameter or four feet in length.

Tip: Just as it is with bags, brush bundles should not exceed 40 pounds of weight per bundle.

Compost It! Bin

Cost: \$53 one-time charge for the 96-gallon cart and \$105 annual renewal. Place the cart curbside during Compost It! Season.

Tip: This is equivalent to 65 bags per year, plus this is a simple alternative if you do not want to hassle with bags and like the ease of wheeling a cart to the curb.

Boards & Commissions

Make a difference in your community by volunteering for a City Board or Commission. Residents can volunteer to help guide the City of Bondurant by serving on one of five boards and commissions, each with specific responsibilities. Boards and commissions study information in specific areas and make recommendations to the city council on issues within that board or commission's area of expertise. Appointments to city boards and commissions are made by the Mayor and confirmed by the City Council of Bondurant.

CITY COUNCIL. City Council priorities focus on improving city services and promoting viable opportunities to meet the needs of a growing community. Those areas include supporting public education, growth, bikeways and open spaces. Meets the first and third Monday of each month, 6 p.m. at City Hall.

BOARD OF ADJUSTMENTS. The primary duties of the Board of Adjustments include granting variances from the terms of the City's Zoning Ordinance, granting conditional use permits, and conducting hearings on appeals of administrative interpretations pertaining to the City's Zoning Ordinance. Meets the second Tuesday of each month, 5 p.m. at City Hall.

LIBRARY BOARD OF TRUSTEES. The primary duties of the

Board are to develop policies for the library including circulation of materials, library equipment, and use of the facility by individuals and groups; provide general direction to the Library Director concerning library functions and services; approve a yearly library budget; approve library expenses as they occur; approve personnel decisions concerning library staff including hiring of employees; and, on a periodic basis, represent the library at City Council and other meetings. Meets the first Wednesday of each month, 7 p.m. at the library.

PARKS & RECREATION BOARD. The primary duties of the Board are to investigate and encourage leisure programs and facilities; promote health, welfare and well being of citizens; adopt policies and regulations for Parks & Recreation; advise the Council on Parks & Recreation plans; and report to the Council on past activities and future recommendations. Meets the third Thursday of each month, 6 p.m. at City Hall.

PLANNING & ZONING COMMISSION. The primary duties of the commission are to review applications and make decisions on new commercial and residential developments such as subdivisions, retail, and office complexes, by adopting and enforcing zoning regulations, review and provide comments on street and park improvements; and develop the City's long-term plan for development. Meets the second and fourth Thursday of each month, 6 p.m. at City Hall.

In the City of Bondurant, you will experience life connecting.

On behalf of the City Council and City employees, it is my pleasure to share with you some updates of various activities in Bondurant — a city at the crossroads of growth and opportunity.

The City recently experienced another large valuation growth last year, with more than 15 percent increase from the previous fiscal year. The valuation increase reflects the City's growth, and, over the next few years, it should be significantly more due to large industrial projects under construction. This upward trend has continued over the last several years and clearly demonstrates Bondurant's attractiveness to residents and business.

Our great city has so much to offer, from education to recreation, we believe there is something here for every person and every business. We have a highly experienced Fire Department and EMS service that continues to be one of the best in the area and has been recognized with an international award for innovation in protecting public health and safety.

If you are looking for community events, festivals and activities, you are in the right place.

Our residents take great pride in Bondurant's uniqueness by offering a broad range of year-round civic and cultural events such as our annual Bondurant Summerfest, Bondu Spook-tacular, Battle of the Bands, Celebrate Bondurant, Bondu Blues & Brews, Bondurant Farmers Market, multiple Chichaqua Valley Trail biking events, and many other events.

Our beautiful parks and recreation facilities provide a remarkable quality of life for residents. In addition to some of the best softball and baseball fields in Iowa, the Bondurant Regional Sports Complex now includes soccer fields. The City also offers miles of paved trails as well as fishing and canoeing opportunities. Lake Petocka is stocked with rainbow trout, bluegill, channel catfish, largemouth bass, white bass and yellow perch. You can

also enjoy picnic shelters and a paved walking path surrounding the Lake Petocka waterfront. The ponds in Eagle Park are also great places for fishing! The city also has parks and playground equipment located within residential neighborhoods. Finally, the Library hosts activities continually and is currently expanding to meet the community's needs.

Additionally, over the last few years, the City has expanded the biking/walking trails connecting to the Chichaqua Valley Trail with additional trail connections to surrounding communities. A great place along the trail system is the Bondurant Trailhead Depot to rest or start your adventure. A southern trail connection from the Bondurant Trailhead along the Gay Lea Wilson trail will access the community Gateway Park and the award-winning Porch Swing and Fireflies display. Soon an underpass at Highway 65 will connect Gay Lea Wilson trail to surrounding communities to the south.

Arts and cultural activities enhance the quality of life for our residents. In support of this effort, the Bondurant Community Foundation has funded a public art display in Gateway Park and more recently an art mural on the Bondurant-Farrar Bus Barn showcased along the Chichaqua Valley Trail.

Whether you already live in Bondurant or are moving here, I encourage you to continually explore the great quality of life we offer that is an ideal environment where families and businesses can flourish. The City Council and I are committed to collaborating with city organizations/boards, the school district, private businesses, and the citizens of Bondurant to improve the overall quality of life.

Together, we can help sustain appealing growth, meet the needs of the citizens, and keep Bondurant brimming with opportunity.
